Post Event Permit Payment Process

After each Event, the individual responsible for Permit payments must log into the Motorsport Management Platform to record the number of competitors and complete the checkout process.

For those choosing to pay via bank transfer or cheque, please select the "Invoice" option during checkout and ensure that the invoice number is used as the payment reference.

Please note: BACS payments should not reference the Permit number and should only be made after completing the online checkout process. Failing to do so may result in delays in financial reconciliation.

Sustainable Rally Charter Reminder

Omagh Motor Club have also become the first Rally club to be fully compliant with the Sustainable Rally Charter!

If your club organises Stage Rallies, then this is a reminder that the Sustainable Rally Charter is **mandatory**. To be compliant, your club needs to do the following...

- Agree to the [Sustainable Rally Charter](#) – you can do this simply by sending an email to rally@motorsportuk.org stating that you agree!
- Use the [Carbon Calculator](#) tool at one of your events – it doesn't necessarily need to be used at a stage rally! If it's easier, you can use it at an Autotest or 12 car. There are plenty of Environmental Volunteers who are happy to attend events and help you use the calculator too. Contact sustainability@motorsportuk.org for more details.

- Achieve the Motorsport UK Sustainability Accreditation – You can find full details of how to apply [here](#), or if you need any help getting started, please contact club.development@motorsportuk.org.
