Updates from Competitions and Clubs

Training Days - Permits

This is a reminder that clubs holding training days need to apply for a Certificate of Exemption training permit. This is a free permit and can be accessed through Sport:80.

Each training day permit should be submitted with a comprehensive risk assessment. A Risk Assessment template is available in the <u>Resource Centre</u>.

Competitor Signing-On

The Competitors Signing-On Declarations have been updated in line with NCR V10. Please make sure you are using the updated Declaration. This will be mandatory from 01 September 2025. You can find the updated forms in the Resource Centre.

Event Finder - Permit titles

When applying for a permit we advise all clubs to write the event disciplines in the title. This will ensure when searching for specific disciplines in the event finder, your event will be displayed.

For example – If Summer Swing is an AutoTest rename it Summer Swing AutoTest.
