

SAFEGUARDING & WELFARE AGREEMENT FOR KART CLUBS



As a Motorsport UK-registered kart club, it is important that you have in place measures to ensure the safety of all members and participants. This list is designed to help you meet necessary safeguarding standards. It is supported by a handbook and resources to help you create a safe environment for your community.

GOVERNANCE

- Safeguarding is a standing agenda item on Committee meetings, we commit to provide an opportunity for cases to be discussed and learning identified
- We have a Club Safeguarding policy and procedure which explains how we will recognise, respond to and report any safeguarding concerns
- We have a Motorsport UK-Licensed Club Safeguarding Officer in post
 - *They have completed their CSO training*
 - *Their role is publicised and promoted with name and contact details*
 - *They are available to be contacted at every event*
- Our contracts with other providers refer to the club's safeguarding policy and procedures and contracts stipulate that people working in regulated activity must provide copies of their suitability check

RACE WITH RESPECT

- The Race with Respect code of conduct is publicised and promoted along with our clubs' anti-bullying statement
- Race With Respect materials are visibly displayed

SAFE RECRUITMENT PRACTICES

- We have a Safe Recruitment policy outlining the steps we will take to prevent unsuitable people working with children and adults at risk including how confidential data will be stored and used
- We will consider all roles in our club and commit to ensure that anyone working in regulated activity has a suitability check completed through Motorsport UK
- All new staff members and volunteers will complete a safeguarding induction
- All Marshals are encouraged to register with Motorsport UK

REPORTING PROCESSES

- Information on how to report safeguarding concerns to both the Club Safeguarding Officer and Motorsport UK is available on our website
- We display posters which promote the importance of reporting issues of poor behaviour and safeguarding concerns
- We have guidance available for children and young people, parents and guardians to encourage reporting
