British Motorsport Trust

Every year the British Motorsport Trust invest hundreds of thousands of pounds into making UK motorsport safer for competitors, officials, and marshals.

The Trust has played a pivotal role in funding the introduction of FIA High-Tech light panels at UK circuits, providing resurfacing works and barriers at Karting and Hill Climb venues and supporting clubs with rescue & recovery vehicles as well as other vital safety equipment. If you have competed or volunteered in motorsport in the UK, you would have benefitted from the work of the Trust.

In order to continue the current levels of investment, the Trust is reliant on the UK motorsport community to support its work.

We encourage Clubs to promote the British Motorsport Trust, and as such we have produced promotional materials to use on event regulations and other documentation. You can find a template here, and we also have a PNG file available on request.

Event Official Registrations

Applications for our new Event Official Registrations are now open. The new grades added onto the Sport:80 platform include Event Steward, Event Secretary, Event Safety Officer (Stage Rally), Competitor Liaison Officer (Stage Rally) and specific registrations for Clubs operating events under a Super K-X Karting permit.

Registrations are not mandatory but are intended to better recognise the tremendous work carried out by volunteers across the UK who haven't previously had the option to register with the governing body. In addition, we hope these registrations will allow us to better communicate with individuals carrying out these roles and provide training and support opportunities.

As a Registered Club, we would be grateful if you could encourage your members that undertake these roles to register with us. Applicants will need to supply a letter of nomination from a Club for the role(s) they are applying for. Once your application is approved you will receive a digital registration card which can be downloaded onto your smartphone wallet.
