Nomination Guidance

The Motorsport UK Club and Volunteer of the Year Awards are open for nominations and will close on 30th October 2026.

The Motorsport UK Volunteer of the Year awards recognise excellence and commitment across our volunteer workforce. Now in its 34th year, previous winners have demonstrated exceptional dedication to motorsport members and enhancing the motorsport community.

The awards are open to all volunteers.

Nomination guidance and information:

- Nominations are to be submitted via the online nomination form, and only information submitted on this form can be considered by the awards panel. Once you have started either the Club or the Volunteer of the Year nomination form online, you can save your progress and complete it in stages until you are ready to submit your nomination.
- Please only submit one nomination; there's no need to submit multiple nominations for the same nominee.
- Nominations are reviewed by an external panel and all identifying information (e.g. motor club names, names of individuals etc.) is redacted so the panel cannot see this information. We would recommend using the "PEE" method; make your Point, share your Evidence and Explain what you are sharing. The nomination forms have word limits so this will help to shape your nomination.
- The panel will score each nomination against certain criteria; the example attributes on the nomination forms give a great clue as to what they are looking for!
- There is no limit to the number of endorsements an Association can make for the Motorsport UK Club of the Year Award and no limit to the number of endorsements/nominations a Club, Group or Association can make for the Motorsport UK Volunteer of the Year Award.
- Nominated clubs and volunteers will be contacted directly by the end of December 2026.
- No Motorsport UK employee or contractor can nominate for the awards.
