NCR 2026 - Fee implementations (please note)

As we look ahead to 2026, a small number of updates will be introduced within the NCR to support the continued safe and effective delivery of events, and to ensure we can maintain a consistent level of service for our clubs.

Stage Rally Safety Delegates

From 2026, a Stage Rally Safety Delegate fee will be introduced for all Stage Rally events. This will be set at the same rate as the existing Stewards fee and reflects the important role Safety Delegates play in strengthening event safety standards.

Late permit application fee

A late permit application fee of **£35** will be implemented. While these timeframes were outlined in the 2025 NCR, this fee will now apply where applications are submitted within the periods below, as late applications require additional resource to process within tighter timescales:

- **International or National events:** within 8 weeks
- **Interclub events:** within 6 weeks
- **Clubmans events:** within 4 weeks

Late permit payment fee

To help ensure timely processing, a late permit payment fee of **£10 per week** will apply where permit fees are paid more than 30 days after the due date.
