

Dear Competitor

You have received a decision of the Stewards together with this document which sets out a Judicial Process summary which is for Competitor guidance only.

This does not replace the Regulations set out in the National Competition Rules (NCR), which take precedence over any guidance issued. It is the sole responsibility of Competitors to be familiar with and follow the published NCR.

Please note, all Officials have been instructed not to provide you with any advice on the Appeal process.

APPEAL TO THE NATIONAL COURT AGAINST A DECISION OF THE STEWARDS
(Non-Technical)

Appeals must be submitted in accordance with NCR Ch.2 App.7 Art. 5.

Ch.2 App.7 Art 5.4 – Submitting the Appeal

Notice of Intention to Appeal must be submitted in writing stating the grounds for Appeal in accordance with Ch.2 App.7 Art5.3. The Appeal must be signed and accompanied by an undertaking to pay the correct fee (See Ch.1 App.2).

Appeals must be lodged with the Event Secretary, the Clerk of the Course or one of their deputies within 30 minutes of the decision first being communicated, or 7 days if the decision was delivered solely in writing / electronically.

Ch.2 App7 Art.5.10 – Confirmation of Appeal

After submitting your Notice of Intention to Appeal you must submit Confirmation of Appeal to the National Court Administration within 10 days to nationalcourtadmin@motorsportuk.org .

This confirmation must specify the Grounds of Appeal and all supporting arguments and must be signed.

Ch.2 App .7 Art 5.13

On receipt of your Confirmation of Appeal and the documentation contained within the Motorsport UK Stewards Report, the National Court Administration will refer the matter to a Chair of the National Court who will advise within 10 days as to whether the Appeal meets either of the criteria specified in Ch.2 App.7 Art 5.3.

If it is considered that your Appeal **does not** meet either of the criteria **and it is a validly lodged Appeal**, your Appeal fails and the Appeal fee will be forfeit.

If it is considered that your Appeal **does** meet the criteria arrangements will be made for the National Court to be convened.

Ch.2 App.7 Art .18

Where an Appeal is permitted to hearing then, **unless otherwise directed by the National Court**. You must submit to the National Court Administration your skeleton argument within 10 days of being notified of that decision This should include:

- Identify all Regulations referred.
- Identify all your witnesses
- Specify the factual basis of the Appeal, including the evidence to be given in support of your Appeal

We recommend you review Ch.2 App.7 in full.
