

Dear Competitor

You have received a decision of the Clerk of the Course together with this document which sets out a Judicial Process summary which is for competitor guidance only.

This does not replace the Regulations set out in the National Competition Rules (NCR) which take precedence over any guidance issued. It is the sole responsibility of Competitors to be familiar with and follow the published NCR.

Please note, all Officials have been instructed not to provide you with any advice on the Appeal process.

APPEAL TO THE NATIONAL COURT AGAINST A DECISION OF THE CLERK OF THE COURSE (Technical)

Appeals must be submitted in accordance with NCR Ch.2 App.7.

Technical Eligibility Appeals are not heard by the Stewards of the Event but are referred directly to the National Court.

Ch.2 App.7 Art.6.4 – Submitting the Appeal

Notice of Intention to Appeal must be submitted in writing and lodged with the Secretary of the Event, the Clerk of the Course or one of their deputies within 30 minutes of the decision first being notified.

The Appeal must be signed and accompanied by an undertaking to pay the correct fee (Ch.1 App.2).

Ch.2 App.7 Art 6.10

Within 10 days of submitting your Notice of Intention to Appeal you must submit in writing to the National Court Administration detailed reasons for appealing. f

Your submission should include detailed reasons for appealing, quote any applicable regulation numbers and relevant technical specifications.

The Technical Official(s) is also required to submit their reasons for issuing the Non-Compliance report.

The National Court Administration will forward you a copy of the Scrutineer's submission for comment within 10 days.

Ch.2 App.7 Art 6.13

The National Court Administration will forward you a copy of the Scrutineer's second submission. You will have 7 days to respond to only any new matters that have been raised.

Technical Appeals are considered at closed hearing considering only written submissions with suitable experts, which means that no parties will attend to provide oral submissions.

We recommend you review Ch.2 App.7.
